Rules and Regulations:

1. This year there we be a triple crown overall winner awarded to the top performing bar b q team in brisket, pork ribs, and chicken breast. To be eligible, a team must enter all 3 events. When you win in these 3 categories, your team will be awarded points. Points for each category are awarded as followed: 10 points for 1st place, 9 points for 2nd place, and so on to 10th place which will place get 1 point. These points will be added up together and the team with the highest total will be the overall winner. If there is a tie, the team with the highest place in brisket will be the winner. If there is a tie and neither team placed in brisket, then team with the highest place in pork ribs will be the winner. If you enter more than one time in a category, only your top place will count towards points. For example, if you enter brisket twice and win both time with 4th place and 7th place. Your team will receive 7 points for your 4th place and no points for 7th place.
2. Beef Brisket: Plaques awarded for 1st-10th Place.
3. Pork Ribs: Plaques awarded for 1st-10th Place. Note: NO BABY BACKS - Pork Spare Ribs Only.
4. Chicken Breast: Plaques awarded for 1st-10th Place
5. Jackpot Beans: Plaques awarded for 1st-10th Place. On the beans, there will be an 80% payback to 1st-3rd places. Amount for each place will be determined by the number of entries.
6. BBQ Sauce: Plaques awarded for 1st-6th Place.
7. Chef's Choice: Plaques awarded for 1st-7th Place. This is a new and exciting category that we think will be fun this year. For this, a team can enter anything they wish as long as it is made on a BBQ Pit.
8. Each team must be in compliance with all health department rules and regulations.
9. Each team will be assigned a Bar B Q area for cooking. Size of each spot is yet to be determined. RV's are welcomed, but electricity will be very limited, so generators may be needed. No BBQ teams will be allowed to pre-mark their spots. If spot is marked off before being assigned by the BBQ committee, it will be removed. Early Set-Up will begin at noon on Thursday, June 2, 2011.

10. There will be no vehicles allowed in the cooking area. All vehicles will need to be removed after unloading your BBQ setup. We are very limited on space and a path for emergency vehicles will be needed. No ATV's, 4-wheelers, or golf carts will be allowed.
